### IN OUR CHURCH

We kicked off 2024 by taking Northview Worship on tour! Pastor CJ and our Executive Pastors, along with many of our Northview Worship leaders, traveled to seven campuses to bring a powerful night of worship, teaching a communion to many of the communities our campuses reside in. Hundreds of people were blessed by the opportunity to hear live teaching from Pastor CJ and enter into a powerful time of worship with their friends and families.

Our entire church also launched into a time of powerful and intentional focus on God through 21 Days of prayer and fasting. We were able to encourage thousands of attendees through our 21 Days of prayer and fasting devotional and provide digital access to prayer and fasting resources through the launch of our brand-new Northview app.

### IN OUR COMMUNITY

In 2023, Northview's Missions team saw immense impact in our community, largely thanks to our congregation's incredible generosity during the **F1RST** initiative. Northview managed to offer Christmas gifts to **over 3,000** children in Indiana. Additionally, we supported families with essential items like food and hygiene supplies, ensuring their needs were met through the year's end.

One of the areas of impact was Northview's support of the Brookside Christmas Store, serving **75 families** from the community. One emotionally overwhelmed mother shared that she had never experienced such generosity from a church and tearfully expressed her gratitude to our staff and volunteers. Through the provision received from God through the **F1RST** initiative, she could provide for her children.

This is one story out of many. These outreach endeavors have not just aided individuals and families in need but have also served as an open invitation for hundreds to encounter the love of Christ, often for the very first time.



### IN OUR WORLD

In our world today, more than 3.2 billion people live in a region known as the 10/40 Window, where 98% of the population has little to no access to the Gospel, a church, or even a Christian. In addition, this region is where the poorest in our world live. The need is glaring. And yet, only one percent of Christian mission investment goes towards reaching these families.

Part of our commitment through **F1RST** has been to minister to those in the 10/40 Window.

All of our monthly giving towards Filter of Hope, Venture, and OneHope is devoted to reaching and caring for this region. Practically speaking, **over 62,000** have received filters for clean water, **over 79,000** have heard the Gospel message, and **over 11,000** have chosen faith in Jesus through the Gospel.

It is often dangerous to be a Christian in these countries, so all of this ministry work is being carried out solely by national leaders in their own countries. Foreigners, especially Americans, would be flagged as a threat and could put national Christians in danger by association. That is why supporting the local leaders through prayer and finances is our best way to help and what we as a church are committed to.
